In camera clausa, & in proposito pariete representare quicquid extra cameram è regione veleſt, vel geritur, quod quidem in oculos incurrit.

Hanc artem primus, quod sciam, I. Baptista Porta tradidit, magiæque naturalis non minimam partem fecit. Sed experientiâ contentus, demonstrationem non addidit. Atqui vel hoc solo experimento potuissent Astronomi statuere de sua deliqui solaris imagine.

Claudantur igitur omnes rimæ cameræ, adeò ut ne minima lucula possit ingredi, è regione verò fenestræ, quæ prospectum habet ad res repræsentandas, sit paries albus, cæteri nigri. Aperiatur foramen in fenestra angustissimum, quantum visus fortitudini sufficit, sic tamen, vt si paries vel fenestra crassior fuerit, partes foramen circumstantes opacæ rescindantur, quo ad tibi prospectus per foramē pateat ad omnes res foris collocatas, quas cupis repræsentare. Sintque spectatoris oculi per horæ quadrantem vel semis cohibiti ab aspectu lucis diurnæ, quoad euanuent species in clara diei luce spiritib. impressæ, per ea quæ in conclusione primi capitilis dicta sunt. Quare per sextā huius capitilis, illustrabūt res externæ parietē intus oppositum, sic vt figura parietis illustrati confundatur quidem ex figurâ fenestræ, & rerū quæ foris sunt, sed tamen cum fenestra præsupponatur angustissima, respectu distantie fenestræ à pariete, minimū defigura fenestræ, figuræ rerū consistentiū permiscebif.
