TAURICA Chersonesus, quam Præcop & Tartariam minorem hodie appellant, ampla peninsula, inter Pontum Euxinum & Mæotim usque ad Bosporum Cimmerium, qui Europam ab Asia discernit, porrigitur. Eam medium horridi & ardui montes velut Apenninus Italiam in boream & australem dirimunt. Australem, cuius metropolis est Capha 63: 38. 47: 15. olim dicta Theodosia, emporio celebris, quā Mahometes anno 1475. occupauit & sibi tributariam fecit. In boreali vero parte Tartari, Crimæi vulgo appellati latissimos inter Boristhenem & Tanaim campos, pascuis subinde mutatis peruagantes, sedem Regiam annos iam ferè quadringentos habuerunt oppidum Crimæum 63: 18. 47: 38. vnde & Crimæi Tartari appellati fuerunt. Hi postea perfonso Tauricæ ad insulæ formam Istmo, circa fossam eam quam Præcop appellant, ciuitatem eiusdem nominis & Regiam sedem 62: 12. 48: 12. cum condidissent, Præcopenses Tartari inde dicti sunt. Horum Rex Turcis confederatus & socius, cum propriis fratribus instigantibus Turcis, à quibus bello petebatur, submouisset, & Capham obsidione premeret, à suis consiliarijs ad hoc amplis muneribus corruptis, cum duobus filiolis in frustra concus, Ottomannicæ amicitiae infelix exemplum præbuit: Eo enim occiso tartari, qui haec tenus liberi & indomiti, ex socijs & fratribus Ottomannorum facti sunt serui & ad similitudinem aliarum Turcicarum prouinciarum non Regem, sed Beglerbegum, id est, Vice Regem accipere coacti sunt. Qualc autem sit Turcum imperium, né actum quod dicitur agamus, ex VVa. Iachia & Gracia inscriptionibus facile potest cognosci, eo Lectorem breuitatis causa remittimus. Præter Caſan autem & Astrachan Regna Tartarorum, qui agros colunt domosque inhabitant & nunc Mosco subiiciuntur, præterque dictos Præcopenses, sunt & alij tartari campestres, qui cateruatim in campis nullis finibus obseruatis degunt & in hordas veluti in quasdam prouincias, à quibus & cognominantur, diuisi sunt, de his suo loco, Asiaticis videlicet tabulis, dicemus.
