 liae Originē habuit: quā Lii⁹ patauin⁹ & Trog⁹ pompey⁹ narrāt a gallis qui duce Breno in yta-
 liam ascēderāt populiq; loca incolētes in quib⁹ est edificata Insubres appellabāt impante assue-
