Mediolanū ciuitas potētissima apud insubres totū. Cisalpine gallie metropol' t' vrbū ceterarū. Ma-
ter Originē habuit; quā **Liu**⁹ patauin⁹ t' **Trog**⁹ pompey⁹ narrat a gallis qui duce Brēno in yta
riam ascēderāt populic⁹ loca incolētes in quib⁹ est edificata. Insubres appellabāt impante astue-
ro persarū rege a gallis senonēsib⁹ nō cōdita ut multi astruere; sed aucta t' instaurata fuit. Eā tñ Josue he-
breorū iudicis tpe aliq⁹ pmo conditā fuisse dicūt. Et tpsibus troyanorū clarissimā fuisse. Cū Siccambri germanie
